SAN DIEGO – Classic Mediterranean is making way for Italian family favorites in San Diego’s Gaslamp Quarter. Dussini Mediterranean Bistro will close, only to be reborn as The Old Spaghetti Factory’s return to downtown San Diego.

Beginning Feb. 1, Dussini Mediterranean Bistro, located at 275 Fifth Avenue, will close its Gaslamp Quarter restaurant to renovate for the re-opening of The Old Spaghetti Factory, scheduled for a Feb. 23 opening. Throughout the renovation and after the re-opening of The Old Spaghetti Factory, the Dussini Loft Bar will remain open to guests on the upper floor.

After a four-year absence, The Old Spaghetti Factory is committed to bringing family dining back to downtown San Diego. And it’s back by popular demand.

“We continue to receive calls from families asking when we’re going to re-open The Old Spaghetti Factory in San Diego,” said Chris Dussin, president and son of the restaurant’s founder. “We spent significant time looking for a new location, but in the end we decided it would be best to return to our original location, yet keep the popular Dussini Loft Bar intact for its fans.”

Originally the San Diego Old Spaghetti Factory opened in 1974 and closed in 2005 when part of the building was redeveloped for the Hard Rock Hotel. With the re-opening of The Old Spaghetti Factory in San Diego, the restaurant will have 38 locations throughout the country and is currently celebrating its 40th year of business.

The Old Spaghetti Factory is best known as a memorable family dining experience that offers complete meals at a great value. The restaurant also offers an acclaimed kids’ menu. The Old Spaghetti Factory was recently recognized by *Parents* magazine as one of the top 10 family-friendly restaurant chains in the United States.
